**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE PROPER CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE A FIRST AMENDMENT EXTENDING AND MODIFYING THE EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH AND GREGORY P. HARRISON; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, on February 21, 2017, Gregory P. Harrison was appointed as City Manager for the City of Pompano Beach, Florida, and has served in that capacity for the past five years; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Pompano Beach desires to continue the services of Gregory P. Harrison as City Manager as provided by the Charter of the City of Pompano Beach; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to law, ten (10) days' notice has been given by publication in a paper of general circulation in the City, notifying the public of this proposed Ordinance and of a public hearing in the City Commission Chambers of the City of Pompano Beach; and

**WHEREAS**, a public hearing before the City Commission was held pursuant to the published notice described above, at which hearing the parties in interest and all other citizens so desiring had an opportunity to be and were, in fact, heard; now, therefore,

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA:**

**SECTION 1.** That a First Amendment to the Employment Agreement between the City of Pompano Beach and Gregory P. Harrison, a copy of which Amendment is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as if set forth in full, is hereby approved.

**SECTION 2.** That the proper City officials are hereby authorized to execute said First Amendment to the Employment Agreement.

**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage.
