

WHEREAS: Every day, 100 Americans are killed by gun violence and on

average there are nearly 13,000 gun homicides every year; and

WHEREAS: Americans are 25 more times more likely to be killed with guns than

people in other developing countries; and

WHEREAS: Support for the Second Amendment rights of law-abiding citizens

goes hand-in-hand with keeping guns away from dangerous

people; and

WHEREAS: Hadiya Pendleton, a 15-year-old teenager who marched in

President Obama's second inaugural parade and was tragically shot and killed just weeks later in Chicago, should be now

celebrating her 22nd birthday; and

WHEREAS: To help honor Hadiya – and the 100 Americans whose lives are cut

short and the countless survivors who are injured by shootings every day – a national coalition of organizations has designated June 7<sup>th</sup>, 2019 as the 5<sup>th</sup> National Gun Violence Awareness Day;

and

WHEREAS: The idea was inspired by a group of Hadiya's friends, who asked

their classmates to commemorate her life by wearing orange choosing this color because hunters wear orange to announce themselves to other hunters when in the woods and orange is a

color that symbolizes the value of human life; and

WHEREAS: The tragic event at Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School, where

gun violence resulted in the loss 17 students and faculty, and the wounding of 17 others, brings greater attention to the need for

awareness; and

WHEREAS: Anyone can join this campaign by pledging to WEAR ORANGE on

the first weekend in June of 2019, to help raise awareness about gun violence in America, and to honor the lives of gun violence

victims and survivors; and

WHEREAS: We renew our commitment to reduce gun violence and pledge to

do all we can to keep firearms out of the wrong hands and to encourage responsible gun ownership to help keep our children

and our communities safe.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Pompano Beach, Florida, hereby proclaims June 7<sup>th</sup>, 2019 to be National Gun Violence Awareness Day and encourages all citizens to support their local communities' efforts to prevent the tragic effects of gun violence and to honor and value human lives.
