A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO SCHEDULE AND FACILITATE MEETINGS BETWEEN THE CITY COMMISSION AND THE THREE (3) HIGHEST-RANKED CANDIDATES FOR THE POSITION OF DISTRICT CHIEF FOR CONSIDERATION PURSUANT TO THE AGREEMENT FOR POLICE SERVICES WITH THE BROWARD SHERIFF'S OFFICE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission recognizes that the position of its Police Chief is one of the most significant executive leadership positions within the City and has a direct impact on public safety, community trust, and the effective delivery of municipal services; and

WHEREAS, the City's Agreement with the Broward Sheriff's Office ("BSO") for Police Services specifically provides for the selection of the City's District Chief, who serves as the City's Police Chief through a cooperative process involving BSO and the City Manager; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to be informed of the qualifications, experience, leadership, philosophy, and vision of the finalists being considered for appointment as District Chief; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that providing Commissioners with an opportunity to meet with the three (3) highest-ranked candidates prior to the City Manager's final selection will promote transparency, communication, and informed decision-making while preserving the City Manager's authority to make the selection consistent with the City's Code of Ordinances and applicable law; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission intends that such meetings be conducted in compliance with Florida's Government in the Sunshine Law and all other applicable laws; now, therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO
BEACH, FLORIDA:**

SECTION 1. The City Commission hereby directs the City Manager to schedule and facilitate individual meetings with the Mayor, Vice-Mayor, and City Commissioners between the three (3) highest-ranked candidates for the position of District Chief as provided in the City's Agreement for Police Services with the Broward Sheriff's Office. The meetings shall be scheduled prior to the City Manager's final selection for the position in order to first obtain input from said City officials with regard to the final candidates.

SECTION 2. The meetings contemplated by this Resolution shall be conducted in a manner that complies with all applicable provisions of the Florida Government in the Sunshine Law, Chapter 286, Florida Statutes, the Florida Public Records Act, Chapter 119, Florida Statutes, the City's Code of Ordinances, and all other applicable laws and regulations.

SECTION 3. Nothing contained herein shall be construed to alter, diminish, or impair the authority vested in the City Manager to appoint the Police Chief under Section 32.70 of the City's Code of Ordinances, nor the authority outlined in the aforementioned Agreement for Police Services.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
