AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 34, "CITY POLICY," OF THE POMPANO BEACH CODE OF ORDINANCES.  $\mathbf{BY}$ **AMENDING SECTION** 34.0603. "DEFERRED RETIREMENT OPTION PLAN (DROP)," BY **SECTION** "SUPPLEMENTAL **AMENDING** 34.0604, RETIREMENT BENEFIT FOR FIREFIGHTERS," IMPLEMENT RECENT CHANGES IN THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE POMPANO BEACH PROFESSIONAL FIRE FIGHTERS AND THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH FOR THE PERIOD **BEGINNING** OCTOBER 1, 2022 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2025, THAT **MODIFIES** THE **POLICE** AND **FIREFIGHTERS'** RETIREMENT SYSTEM; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; **PROVIDING SEVERABILITY**; **PROVIDING FOR** EFFECTIVE DATE.
