Each firm was given fifteen minutes for their presentation, with a fifteen-minute question-and-answer period immediately following. During their presentations, the firms discussed their capabilities, experience, and approach to the project. The Committee had specific follow-up questions for each firm.

After the final presentation the Committee discussed their perception of each presentation and each firm's overall response to the City's project. Committee members scored the responses using voting forms containing the evaluation criteria published in the RFP, with the following results:

- 1) W.D. Thompson Inc., d/b/a Beach Raker 230
- 2) Universal Beach Services Corp......223

An agenda item will be prepared to present the final ranking to the City Commission for their approval to negotiate and enter into a contract with W.D. Thompson Inc., d/b/a Beach Raker, the highest-ranked firm; with an additional authorization to negotiate with the succeeding ranked firms should an impasse occur in the negotiations with the recommended firm.
