BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That it is the determination of the City Commission of the City of Pompano Beach, Florida, that the Greater Collier City Civic Association, Inc.'s Annual Luncheon, supported by Vice-Mayor Moss, serves a public purpose.

SECTION 2. That the City approves and authorizes the appropriation of a not to exceed amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), from the designated funds for such events for Vice-Mayor Barry Moss, to the Collier City Civic Association, Inc. for its 2019 Annual Luncheon to be held on May 25, 2019, and that such funds shall be disbursed on a reimbursement basis following presentation of verified receipts to the City Manager.
