AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE PROPER CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH AND WATER TAXI OF FORT LAUDERDALE, LLC FOR WATER TRANSPORTATION SERVICES, AND TO AUTHORIZE THE PROPER CITY OFFICIALS TO MAKE NONSUBSTANTIVE AMENDMENTS WITHOUT FURTHER COMMISSION APPROVAL AS MAY BE REQUIRED BY THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT FOR AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FUNDING, AND TO PROVIDE COPIES OF SUCH AMENDMENTS TO THE CITY COMMISSION AND CITY CLERK; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, ten (10) days' notice has been given by publication in a paper of general circulation in the City, notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of a public hearing in the City Commission Chambers of the City of Pompano Beach; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing before the City Commission was held pursuant to the published notice described above, at which hearing the parties in interest and all other citizens so desiring had an opportunity to be and were, in fact, heard; now, therefore,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That an Agreement between the City of Pompano Beach and Pompano Beach Water Taxi Inc. for water transportation services, is approved and a copy of the Agreement is attached and incorporated herein by reference as if set forth in full.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor and City Manager are authorized to execute the Amendment and the Interlocal Agreement and to make nonsubstantive amendments, without additional City

Commission approval, as may be required by the Federal Government for the American Rescue Plan Act Funding, and provide copies of such amendments to the City Commission and City Clerk.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this Ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application and, to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage.
