WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to give recognition to the contributions and public service made by Harold L. Abel, a Pompano Beach resident, by adding the name "Harold L. Abel Street" to a portion of NW 4th Street; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO

BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the designation of a portion of NW 4th Street lying between NW 6th

Avenue and NW 3rd Avenue shall have the dual designation of NW 4th Street and "Harold L. Abel Street," with NW 4th Street to be displayed most prominently on the uppermost portion of appropriate signage.

SECTION 2. That the City Clerk is directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to Broward

County so that the County may prepare and install the appropriate signage.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
