Please allow the following to serve as our Narrative for the amendment to our Major Site Plan for our project Festival Marketplace.

See below summary of the Minor deviations Proposed:

1. Increase or significantly decrease the density of residential development or gross square footage of nonresidential development.

Response: There is no change in the proposed development square footage with this amendment.

2. Increase or decrease the number of building stories;

Response: There is no change in the proposed building stories (1 story) in this amendment.

3. Materially alter the drainage, streets, or other engineering design;

Response: There are no significant modifications to any site or engineering design other than removal of some previously approved modifications.

4. Adversely impact the management of stormwater quality or stormwater quantity;

Response: There are no modifications to the stormwater quality or quantity.

5. Substantially affect the terms of the original approval; or

Response: There are minimal changes other than removal of site work no longer needed.



6. Result in significant adverse impacts on the surrounding properties or the city at large.

Response: There are minimal changes other than removal of site work no longer needed.

7. Any and everything plan wise that involves the modification in conjunction with Festival Industrial Redevelopment.

Response: All revised site and landscape changes are included. There are no proposed changes to the previously approved Racetrac building or fuel pumps (elevations and floor plans remain the same).
