A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE ANNUAL BUDGET OF ESTIMATED EXPENDITURES/EXPENSES AND RECEIPTS/REVENUES FOR THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026 TOTALING \$431,373,685; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission has met to ascertain the amount of money which must be raised to conduct the affairs of the municipality for the ensuing 2025-2026 fiscal year so that the business of the municipality may be conducted on a balanced budget and has also determined the amount necessary to be raised by ad valorem taxes and other taxes upon all of the property, real and personal, within the corporate limits of the City of Pompano Beach; now, therefore,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA:

**SECTION 1.** That the following tentative itemization of estimated expenses and receipts for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2025, and ending September 30, 2026, totaling \$431,373,685, as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof by this reference as if set forth in full, is hereby agreed upon and adopted along with the supporting data relating thereto on file in the City Manager's Office of the City of Pompano Beach as the tentative 2025-2026 Budget of the City of Pompano Beach. The amount of money for all of the respective purposes is set forth in Exhibit "A" for the operation and maintenance expenses and debt service expenses of said City during the fiscal year and is hereby appropriated to those respective purposes. The estimated amount of tentative revenues to be derived from sources other than by millage levied on ad valorem tax assessments during the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2025, and ending

2026 fiscal year is set forth in Exhibit "A."
SECTION 2. That a public hearing to adopt a final budget shall be held in accordance
with Section 200.065, Florida Statutes.
