RE: **Request for Resolution-Approval of FY 2025 CDBG Subrecipient Agreements-October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026**

The Office of Housing and Urban Improvement (OHUI) requests a Resolution to approve and authorize the proper City Officials to Execute Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Public Service Program Subrecipient Agreements between the City of Pompano Beach and various non-profit corporations.

The following subrecipients were approved as part of the CDBG Annual Action Plan by the City Commission on July 8, 2025, for the FY 2025-2026 funding year. This project will help with services to various public service activities for the residents of Pompano Beach. The funding will assist with provisions of, among other things, emergency shelter for victims of domestic violence and homeless youth, transitional support for those seeking to re-enter the workforce, free healthcare services, and education programs (tutoring/mentoring) for Pompano Beach youth. The Resolution will approve the required Subrecipient Agreement for the Utilization of CDBG funds in FY 2025-2026 for the following organizations:

- Firewall Centers, Inc. - \$10,000.00

Totaling \$143,000.00 in FY 2025 CDBG funds.
