A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, WAIVING FORMAL COMPETITIVE BIDS DUE TO URGENT CIRCUMSTANCES AND AWARDING A CONTRACT TO YOUNGQUIST BROTHERS, INC. TO CONSTRUCT A CLASS I DEEP INJECTION WELL; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE PROPER CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH AND YOUNGQUIST BROTHERS, INC.; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, during the past year the City attempted unsuccessfully to reline its deep well serving the membrane treatment water plant and the well then had to be abandoned; and

WHEREAS, without being able to run the membrane treatment plant at 100% capacity, we have been at risk of exceeding our consumptive use permit with the South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD); and

WHEREAS, the City's finished water quality to the residents is impacted by not being able to have the proper blend of lime softening and membrane waters, since the membrane plant's production is restricted; and

WHEREAS, the City is currently discharging and paying for the disposal of the concentrate waste from the membrane plant to the sanitary sewer system instead of the well and are being charged for approximately one million gallons a day for treatment at Broward County wastewater treatment plant; and

WHEREAS, the City's chemical costs for lime increased by \$195,000, \$350,000 to \$545,000 this year, due to running the lime plant more; and

WHEREAS, Youngquist Brothers, Inc. is one of two companies in the State capable of, and experienced to, drill this type and size of injection well; and

WHEREAS, the other of the two aforementioned companies had been retained by the City and failed to meet its objectives resulting in an abandonment of the old well, and also recently provided a quote for a similar new injection well in Lee County that is almost twice as much for the same work proposed by Youngquist Brothers, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, in order to not violate the City's consumptive use permit with SFWMD, continue to meet regulatory compliance standards, and reduce the inordinate, continual expenditures currently being incurred, it is urgent that the City enter into this contract with Youngquist Brothers, Inc.; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City Commission finds that the above "Whereas" clauses are true and correct.

SECTION 2. That an Agreement between the City of Pompano Beach and Youngquist Brothers, Inc., a copy of which Agreement is attached hereto and incorporated by reference as if set forth in full, is hereby approved.

SECTION 3. That the proper City officials are hereby authorized to execute said Agreement between the City of Pompano Beach and Youngquist Brothers, Inc.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> This Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
