Comments

This old gumbo limbo is codominant almost from the very base and divides into 3 nearly equal trunks at about 18" above ground level. One trunk (to south) has a cavity that takes up most of the heartwood and may weaken the tree. However, it looks a bit healthier than in 2013 when I first evaluated this gumbo limbo, and it had a very sparse canopy that is now say, 20% fuller. So...despite a lot of foot traffic from the bus stop to the pharmacy door (hundreds of people a day makin' a beeline to their urgency) and despite a cavity that would theoretically weaken and take out this old soldier, the reality is that gumbo limbo is a tough ol' bird and keeps on outliving the odds against it...may we be the same...
