

**CITY OF POMPANO BEACH
Broward County, Florida**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING A POLICY DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER AND STAFF TO RESERVE ALL REMAINING PLOTS AT THE CITY'S MUNICIPAL CEMETERY FOR SALE ONLY TO RESIDENTS OF THE CITY; TO RESTRICT THE NUMBER OF PLOTS SOLD TO ANY PERSON; AND TO ESTABLISH A FEE FOR TRANSFER OF CEMETERY PLOTS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, as of April 16, 2026, the City's Municipal Cemetery had a total of 632 burial plots (404 full-body burial and 228 Columbarium (cremation) plots), remain for use; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 92.16 (B) of the City's Code of Ordinances, the City Commission shall make, adopt and enforce rules and regulations for the use, care, control, management, restriction and protection of the cemetery and all parts and subdivisions thereof; and for restricting and limiting the use of all property within the Cemetery; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission is greatly concerned about the availability of this limited resource for City residents; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City Commission recognizes that the number of remaining full body burial plots and Columbarium plots at the City's Municipal Cemetery are a limited and diminishing resource.

SECTION 2. That the City Commission hereby directs the City Manager and the Public Works Director to reserve all remaining plots at the City's Municipal Cemetery for sale

only to City residents with such residency to be established as provided in Section 92.01 of the City's Code of Ordinances.

SECTION 3. That the City Commission directs that no more than two (2) plots may be sold to any one person. The Director of Public Works may authorize the sale of additional lots to any person who has established City residency upon proof of need based upon the number of existing minor children that exceed the purchase limitation provided herein.

SECTION 4. That the City Commission directs that a fee in the amount of \$295.00 for transfer of cemetery plots be established to cover administrative expenses for processing such transfer. Said fee shall not be applicable for plots repurchased by the City pursuant to § 92.52 (B) of the Code of Ordinances. The transfer fee may also be adjusted to cover additional expense upon City Commission approval.

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
