b.) Painted Mural

The budget for the painted mural is \$3,000.00. Call to Artist was posted May 7, 2019 and the deadline was June 27, 2019. Eighty-two (82) applications were submitted, and five (5) were denied because they did not meet requirements. After the Committee voted online through CAFÉ, the applications were narrowed down to twenty-five (25) submissions scoring 2.0 or higher.

Ms. Atria showed a slide show of the top twenty-five (25) artist painted murals.

The first (1st) artist was Luz Angel.

Mr. Davis described the piece as hopeful and atomistic.

Ms. Maguire stated his piece was her favorite.

The second (2nd) artist was William Luis.

Ms. Aycock liked the fact that the artist used the entire wall.

The Committee decided to run through all twenty-five (25) artist and did a process of elimination.

The Committee really liked Timothy Smith artwork; however, they were concerned about him traveling from California to Florida.

The Committee suggested keeping Luz Angel as a plan B.

The Committee also suggested keeping Phoebe Joynt as a plan B as well, but there was concerned with the door getting scratched. The Artist would have to move the face of the art work upward.
