### Issue

Staff is seeking approval of an Interlocal Agreement ("ILA") between the City of Pompano Beach ("City") and the Community Redevelopment Agency ("CRA"). The ILA will allow the City to reimburse the CRA for costs associated with Work Authorization No. 1 (See Exhibit "A") between the CRA and Calvin, Giordano & Associates, Inc. ("CGA") to provide professional services in the sum of \$90,000.00 including Owner's Contingency.

### Recommendation

The CRA Staff recommends Approval of the Resolution.

### Background

On July 19, 2016, the CRA Board approved a Resolution to enter into an ILA with the City. The ILA is necessary to allow the City to refund the CRA for professional services to be provided by CGA. CGA will assist the CRA with traffic engineering design services for a new traffic signal at the intersection of MLK Boulevard and NW 27<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

This project was initiated by the CRA and the City as a partnership to improve the MLK Boulevard Corridor. The area, known as the Education Corridor, was targeted for improvements geared to eliminate blight and increase opportunities for private investors. The CRA and the City provided funding for design and construction, respectively.

The CGA Work Authorization will help design a traffic signal that local residents and Staff feel is desirable to provide better traffic controls at the intersection of MLK Boulevard and
