Scope of Authorization  
South Florida Water Polo Club

**A. Introduction/Background**

The Licensee, South Florida Water Polo Club (SFWP) has been a registered club member of the United States Water Polo (#989) since 2003. The club has been active not only in developing athletics, but also in hosting different water polo events from small local competitions to state level competitions to international events.

**B. Objectives**

SFWP will provide and promote water polo programs, for both adults 18 years of age and older and youth ages 5 through 17. In addition, SFWP will also provide coaching staff, according to United States Water Polo regulation, to every training session, competition and clinics.

**C. Scope of Work**

SFWP shall utilize the dive well of the main pool located at the Aquatics Center, 820 NE 18<sup>th</sup> Ave, and additional lanes will be made available when the program reaches thirty (30) or more athletes. The secondary location, if scheduling conflicts occur, will be the Houston Sworn Aquatic Center, 901 NW 10<sup>th</sup> Street.

SFWP shall be responsible for the following:

1. Provide a current certified water polo coach throughout the duration of both programs.
2. Provide program equipment and uniforms for all training, competitions and clinics.
3. During events, shall be responsible for
  - a. Field set up and breakdown
  - b. Goal configuration, set up and breakdown
  - c. Timing and Scoring System set up and breakdown
4. Responsible for all clean up and removal of debris and trash from property used area during and after all practices, clinics and competitions.
5. Maintain two (2) stand-alone storage lockers.
6. Provide fifty (50) hours of youth instruction during the calendar year, free of charge. Schedules for this instruction will be mutually agreed upon between Licensee and City.

City will be responsible for the following:

1. Responsible for all set up and breakdown of deck furnishings (i.e. benches, bleachers, tables, chairs, etc.).
2. Responsible for providing required amount of safety personnel for the duration of the programs.
3. Responsible for lane configuration.
4. Provide free parking available for the public during the programs.
5. Providing two (2) stand-alone storage lockers on site. Additional storage space can be provided by the City upon request by SFWP.

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**D. Work Breakdown Structure**

**Schedule** – Practice Schedule for both adult and youth program shall be: Monday – Thursday 6:30pm – 8:30pm and Saturday 9:30am – 11:30am.

Additional space and lanes will be mutually agreed upon between Licensee and City.

Tournament Schedule – Licensee shall submit the annual tournament schedule before the season begins.

**Compensation** – SFWP will pay a monthly charge of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) to the City for the usage of space for both the youth and adult program at the end of each month. In the event of a mechanical failure that has rendered the facility inoperable for more than three (3) days and the alternative location isn't available due to scheduling conflicts, the City will prorate the monthly rental charge. The daily prorated rate will be based on fifty (\$50) dollars per each day that SFWP isn't able to have access to the property for their program.

The below rental fees are options available to SFWP in addition to the monthly charge:

Facility rental fees:

Full Facility: \$65/hour

Dive Well only: \$33/hour

These fees include both set up and breakdown.

Equipment Fees:

- \$200/day using the City's Equipment and Timing/Scoreboard System
- \$150/day using only the City's Equipment

\*Equipment fees include: tables, chairs, umbrellas, water coolers, tents, PA System
