RE: Request for Resolution – Professional Engineering Design for Runway Rehabilitation and Correction of Expanses of Pavement at the west end of Runway 10-28 to HDR Engineering, Inc.

Background

The airport layout plan (ALP), approved by the FAA in July 2021, identifies an expanse of pavement on Taxiway A adjacent to the Runway 10 threshold. The ALP proposes to install an island in the middle of Taxiway A north of Taxiway K. The island would split the old Taxiway A into new Taxiway connectors 'K1' and 'K2' at the west end of Runway 10-28. The city has requested HDR Engineering, Inc. to perform design services for the Pompano Air Park (PMP) Runway 10-28 rehabilitation and correction of expanses of pavement. The desired task outcome will be creating design documents to support a city bid solicitation for project construction. See attached Exhibit "A" for specific Scope and Fee outline. A contractor is currently completing similar work scope at the east end of Runway 10-28.

Request for Approval

Staff is seeking City Commission approval to execute a resolution for \$170,895.00 to HDR Engineering Inc. for design services. This work is funded from CIP 24-027, Account#465-7766-542.65-03 (City Funding \$12,344.75, FAA Funding \$150,205.50, FDOT funding \$8,344.75).
