A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, CHANGING THE DESIGNATION OF A CERTAIN RIGHT-OF-WAY WITHIN THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH CURRENTLY KNOWN AS NW 8TH AVENUE BETWEEN DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. BOULEVARD TO THE SOUTH AND NW 10TH STREET TO THE NORTH TO A DUAL DESIGNATION OF REV. ALBERT E. JOHNSON AVENUE AND NW 8TH AVENUE WITH NW 8TH AVENUE TO BE DISPLAYED ON THE UPPERMOST PORTION OF SIGNAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to give recognition to the contributions and public service made by Rev. Albert E. Johnson, a Pompano Beach resident, by adding the name "Rev. Albert E. Johnson Avenue" to a portion of NW 8th Avenue; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA;

SECTION 1. That the designation of a portion of NW 8th Avenue lying between Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard to the south and NW 10th Street to the north shall have the dual designation of "Rev. Albert E. Johnson" and NW 8th Avenue, with NW 8th Avenue to be displayed most prominently on the uppermost portion of appropriate signage.

SECTION 2. That the City Clerk is directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to Broward County, so that the County may prepare and install the appropriate signage.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
