DANIEL MILLER AVENUE WITH NW 21<sup>ST</sup> AVENUE TO BE DISPLAYED ON THE UPPERMOST PORTION OF SIGNAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS,** the City Commission desires to give recognition to the contributions and public service made by Rev. Daniel Miller, a Pompano Beach resident, by adding the name "Rev. Daniel Miller Avenue" to a portion of NW 21<sup>st</sup> Avenue; now, therefore,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA:

**SECTION 1.** That the designation of a portion of NW 21<sup>st</sup> Avenue lying between Atlantic Boulevard and NW 8<sup>th</sup> Street shall have the dual designation of NW 21<sup>st</sup> Avenue and "Rev. Daniel Miler Avenue," with NW 21<sup>st</sup> Avenue to be displayed most prominently on the uppermost portion of appropriate signage.

**SECTION 2.** That the City Clerk is directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to Broward County so that the County may prepare and install the appropriate signage.
