A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, CHANGING THE DESIGNATION OF A CERTAIN RIGHT-OF-WAY WITHIN THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH CURRENTLY KNOWN AS NW 21ST AVENUE BETWEEN ATLANTIC BOULEVARD AND NW 8TH STREET TO A DUAL DESIGNATION OF NW 21ST AVENUE AND REV. DANIEL MILLER AVENUE WITH NW 21ST AVENUE TO BE DISPLAYED ON THE UPPERMOST PORTION OF SIGNAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to give recognition to the contributions and public service made by Rev. Daniel Miller, a Pompano Beach resident, by adding the name “Rev. Daniel Miller Avenue” to a portion of NW 21st Avenue; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the designation of a portion of NW 21st Avenue lying between Atlantic Boulevard and NW 8th Street shall have the dual designation of NW 21st Avenue and “Rev. Daniel Miler Avenue,” with NW 21st Avenue to be displayed most prominently on the uppermost portion of appropriate signage.

SECTION 2. That the City Clerk is directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to Broward County so that the County may prepare and install the appropriate signage.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
