Scope of Work  
Zambelli Fireworks

A. Introduction/Background

Zambelli Fireworks will be providing the fireworks service for the City of Pompano Beach's July 4<sup>th</sup> Fireworks Extravaganza.

B. Objectives

This service is to provide a 25 minute fireworks display for the July 4<sup>th</sup> Fireworks Extravaganza.

C. Scope of Work

This program will utilize the Pompano Pier located at 222 Pompano Beach Boulevard in Pompano Beach to operate the fireworks display service. Contractor shall provide:

- Zambelli trained technicians to produce the display.
- All transportation and delivery costs. Transportation provided by Zambelli commercially licensed drivers.
- All necessary safety precautions to provide a safe and spectacular display, assistance with local and state firework display permits.
- Highly choreographed display design to coincide with amplified musical soundtrack preapproved by the City to last the duration of the display
- Twenty Five (25) minute display for a cost of \$45,000.
- Display presentation includes the following:

Opener

40-3" finale salutes  
40-3" red, white, blue color finale shells  
12-4" crackle finale shells  
5-5" assorted color finale shells  
Total- 97 shots in Opener

Body of Program

60-3" assorted color and pattern shells\*  
420-4" assorted color and pattern shells\*  
240-5" assorted color and pattern shells  
Total- 720 shots in Body of Program

\*The 3" and 4" shells will be fired in groups of 2 or 3 shells fired at the same time.

Special Effects

20-49 shot angled barrage cakes  
12-400 shot V shape pattern barrage cakes  
6-408 shot Z shape pattern barrage cakes

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Total- 8,228 Special Effects shots

Grand Finale

120-3" finale salutes

480-3" assorted color finale shells

48-4" assorted color finale shells

50-5" assorted color finale shells

Total- 698 Finale Shots

- Contractor is responsible for cleanup of all fireworks, debris and the pier to the satisfaction of the City.
- Licensee shall notify the City immediately of any conditions of the pier which could jeopardize the safety of the Licensee or the public
- Licensee shall give the City prompt written notice of any accidents occurring at the pier in which damage to the pier or injury to a person occurs.

The CITY shall provide:

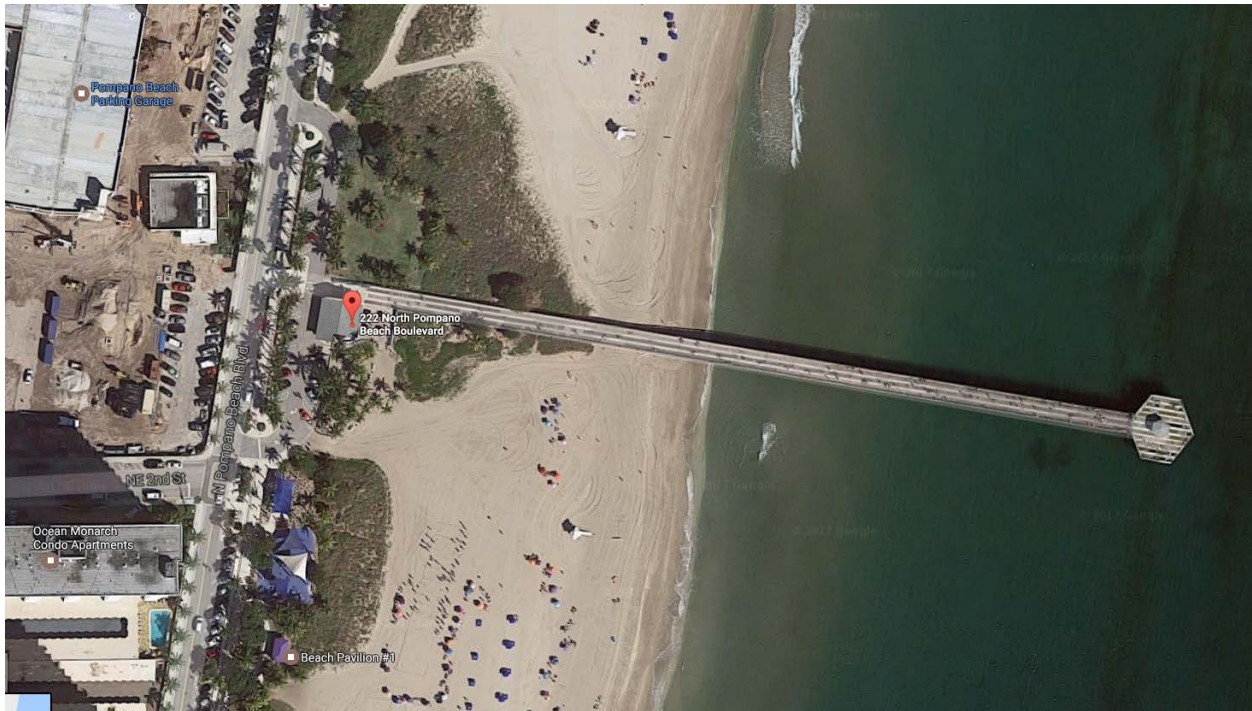
- Two (2) gators with City personnel for assistance with fireworks load in and load out.
- Fire watch personnel upon arrival of the fireworks at the Pier and remain until the Show has been completed.
- Prior to the Show, the City's Fire Marshall or his designee will count the number of barrages and shells to ensure compliance with firework items as described in the Scope of Authorization. After the Show, the Fire Marshall or designee will recount any defective or unspent shells to ensure the City will receive credit for same from by Contractor.
- The City's Fire Marshall or designee will certify start and end time of the Show.
- The City will provide trash bags, receptacles and trash truck for fireworks clean up and load out of the Show.

D. Work Breakdown Structure

The term of this agreement will be for one (1) year from the execution of the agreement by both parties. Active Fireworks set up time will begin no earlier than 7:00am on Monday, July 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2017 and clean up of all fireworks and debris to conclude no later than 6:00pm Wednesday, July 5<sup>th</sup>, 2017.

In the event of inclement weather precludes performance of the show on July 4, 2017, the parties agree that the Show shall be rescheduled for July 5, 2017 with corresponding time periods for performance, set up and clean up as providing above and no further compensation shall be due to the Licensee. In the event that inclement weather continues to prevent performance of the show on July 5, 2017, the parties shall agree to postpone the show until another mutually acceptable day/time which shall occur prior to July 4, 2018.

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E. Summary Schedule of Tasks and Deliverables

**Inspection** - An inspection will be conducted by the CITY prior to the fireworks display to ensure that the location is in accordance with the CITY approved site plan. When implementing the site plan LICENSEE shall ensure that no damage is done to the Permitted Area.

**Clean-up of Permitted Area** - LICENSEE shall be responsible for clean-up and debris from fireworks of the Permitted Area during and after the program. LICENSEE shall further be responsible for the dismantling and removal of any supplies and equipment.

**Parking** – City will provide Licensee with adequate parking spaces during the service times. City will close down Pompano Fishing Pier two days prior to the Fireworks Show to ensure ample time for load in, and will remain closed until 5:00 a.m. the day after the Show was completed.
