A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE UPDATE OF THE MULTIJURISDICTIONAL COUNTYWIDE LOCAL MITIGATION STRATEGY (LMS) PLAN APPROVED \mathbf{BY} THE **FEDERAL** EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA) AND **FLORIDA** DIVISION **OF EMERGENCY** MANAGEMENT (FDEM); PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 322 of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, 42 U.S.C. § 5165, as amended by the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (P.L. 106-390), provides for states, tribes and local governments to undertake hazard mitigation planning to reduce the risks from natural hazards; and

WHEREAS, FEMA has implemented various hazard mitigation planning provisions, pursuant to 44 C.F.R. §201.6, and requires local governments to have a FEMA approved mitigation plan in order to apply for and receive project grants; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 44 C.F.R. § 201.6(d)(3), FEMA requires local jurisdictions to review and revise their local mitigation plan every five (5) years to reflect changes in development, progress in local mitigation efforts, and changes in priorities, and resubmit the local mitigation plan for approval in order to maintain eligibility for mitigation project grant funding; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Administrative Code governs the application, project selection and distribution of the FEMA Hazard mitigation program funds and requires local governments to develop a Local Mitigation Strategy plan to reduce the identified hazards within a county; and

WHEREAS, the Local Mitigation Strategy plan is submitted to the Florida Division of Emergency Management for initial review and coordination, then to FEMA for review and approval; and

WHEREAS, between November 2021 and May 2022, Broward County's Emergency
Management Division held quarterly public meetings to gather public comments prior to
submitting the proposed LMS plan to FDEM and FEMA for final review and approval; and
WHEREAS, on July 11, 2023, FDEM approved the proposed LMS plan; and
WHEREAS, FEMA approved the proposed LMS plan on July 31, 2023, contingent upon
its adoption by Broward County;
WHEREAS, Broward County adopted the multijurisdictional LMS plan as approved by
FDEM confirming it meets all requirements for the plan; now, therefore,
BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO
BEACH, FLORIDA:
SECTION 1. That the City of Pompano Beach adopts the update of the multijurisdictional
Countywide Local Mitigation Strategy Plan.
SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
