A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE PROPER CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH AND BROWARD COUNTY FOR STORMWATER IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN THE KENDALL LAKE NEIGHBORHOOD, LYING SOUTH OF COPANS ROAD, EAST OF I-95, WEST OF DIXIE HIGHWAY, AND NORTH OF NW 15TH STREET, FUNDED BY BROWARD COUNTY TRANSPORTATION SURTAX; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Broward County voters approved a 30-year sales surtax (also known as “Penny for Transportation”) to fund statutorily-permissible transportation expenditures in November 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Kendall Lake Neighborhood Stormwater Improvements Project was evaluated for eligibility under Section 212.055(1), Florida Statutes, by the Transportation Surtax Oversight Board and later approved for surtax funding by the Broward County Board of County Commissioners; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the Interlocal Agreement between the City of Pompano Beach and Broward County for stormwater improvements within the Kendall Lake Neighborhood is approved, and a copy of Agreement is attached and incorporated by reference as if set forth in full.

SECTION 2. That the proper City officials are authorized to execute the Interlocal Agreement between the City of Pompano Beach and Broward County.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
