A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE PROPER CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR UNIFORM COLLECTION OF NON-AD VALOREM SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS BETWEEN THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH AND THE BROWARD COUNTY TAX COLLECTOR; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 197.3632, Florida Statutes, authorizes the use of the uniform method of collection for non-ad valorem special assessments by local governments; and

WHEREAS, the uniform method utilizes the annual property tax bill for collection, thereby reducing administrative costs and ensuring timely receipt of revenues necessary to fund essential municipal services; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pompano Beach finds it necessary, equitable, and in the best interests of its residents to use the uniform method of collection for certain non-ad valorem special assessments; and

WHEREAS, the Broward County Tax Collector requires execution of a written agreement with the City prior to inclusion of such non-ad valorem assessments on the tax roll; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Pompano Beach desires to authorize the appropriate City officials to execute said agreement to implement the uniform method of collection, now, therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO
BEACH, FLORIDA:**

SECTION 1. That the City Commission hereby authorizes the execution of an Agreement for the Uniform Collection of Non-Ad Valorem Special Assessments between the City of Pompano Beach and the Broward County Tax Collector, a copy of which Agreement is attached hereto and incorporated by reference as if set forth in full, is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. That the proper City officials are hereby authorized to execute said Agreement between the City of Pompano Beach and the Broward County Tax Collector.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
