Summary Explanation/Background:

The Patricia Davis Community Garden, located at 1089 NW 6th Avenue, began as a CRA initiative to bring urban gardening to the Northwest Pompano Beach CRA district. In 2019, the CRA contracted with The Fruitful Field to manage daily garden operations and programming.

The Fruitful Field's contract expired on February 1, 2024. The CRA desires to allow the City, under the guidance of the Parks and Recreation Department, to continue to operate and use the property for use as a community garden for the Northwest community and will maintain the contract with the Fruitful Field. Both the CRA and the City agree that the use of the licensed premises by city residents as a community garden serves a valid public purpose beneficial to community residents.

Summary Explanation/Background:

The CRA received an incentive program application from Pompano Design, LLC for the Façade and Business Site Improvement Program (Program) offered through the CRA for the property located at 2666 East Atlantic Blvd. The Program is available for aesthetic improvements to the exterior of commercial buildings with restaurant or retail uses. Pompano Furniture and Design (PFD) will be a retail furniture showroom and intends to be the premier destination for individualized furniture and interior design services.

The improvements proposed under the Program application include an overall remodel of the front entrance to include exterior paint, stucco work, decorative paneling, new front windows, doors and signage. The total estimated cost of this project is approximately \$25,255, of which \$20,000 is eligible for reimbursement through this Program.
