Dear Mr. Biggs,

The City of Pompano Beach is interested in abandoning excess right-of-way property that lies adjacent to your front property line (as shown in the attached approximate sketch). The portion of NE 26th Avenue north of NE 13th Street is wider than the typical residential street, due to landscape enhancement on the portion south of NE 13th Street. The width necessary for such landscaping is not needed on this approximate 330-foot segment of NE 26th Avenue, and therefore at the request of a property owner on this segment, the City is willing to narrow the right-of-way to the typical width of a residential street (no pavement will change with this proposed abandonment). If eventually approved by the City Commission, such action would result in your eastern boundary being extended an additional 10 feet east to include the red-hatched area located adjacent to your property, as indicated on the sketch.

This letter is a preliminary inquiry to find out if you and several of your neighbors along that short segment are in favor of this proposed abandonment. If you are in favor of the abandonment, there are several public hearings that must take place in order to proceed with consideration by the City Commission.
