Pompano Beach Strategic Focus Areas

Customer-focused Excellence

Objective: Provide superior services that meet or exceed the requirements and expectations of our community.

- Improve overall customer satisfaction by 2% over the 2023 baseline by 2025
- Improve Net Promoter Score (NPS) by 2025
- Improve overall participant satisfaction with City-sponsored events to ≥ 75% by 2025

Workforce-focused Excellence

Objective: To be the organization of choice by attracting, training, and retaining a competent, capable, and cohesive workforce.

- Reduce workforce-related accident rates ≥ 10% by 2025
- Improve workforce satisfaction with benefits, compensation, and services ≥ 5% over 2023 baseline by 2025

Sustainability-focused Excellence

Objective: Enhance environmental quality for our current and future residents, visitors, and businesses.

- Increase single-family residences using reuse (available purple pipe) water from 77% to 80% by 2025
- Reduce greenhouse gas emissions by at least 10% from 2019 baseline by 2025
- Convert light duty fleet from 0% to 5% electric vehicles (EV) by 2025
- Reduce municipal facility electric consumption per sq. ft. ≥ 5% by 2025
- Develop and implement single-family home program for organic waste diversion (composting) with ≥ 3% participation by 2025
- Achieve 100% street lighting compliance with sea turtle regulations along A1A by 2025

Community-focused Excellence

Objective: Have a safe, beautiful city with "world-class" beaches; economic, health, and recreation opportunities; and enhanced mobility.

- Establish a regional consortium of municipalities to address the underlying issues of homelessness by 2024
- Increase fitness/wellness program offerings by 5% by 2025
- Increase Cultural Center visitorship 5% by 2025
- Maintain top-level Fire and Ambulance accreditations
- Develop mobility / transportation plan to optimize traffic movement through the city by 2025
- Improve firearm-related crime clearance rate from 17% to 20% by 2025

Finance Excellence

Objective: Ensure the financial ability to provide essential municipal services.

- Improve bond rating to AAA by 2028
- Implement the phased master development plan of the new downtown area by 2025

Process Excellence

Objective: Optimize the City's processes and operations to provide cost-effective services that efficiently utilize the City's resources.

- Improve time-to-hire to ≤ 85 days by 2025
- Reduce the cycle time for permitting to less than 10 business days by 2025
- Develop and implement systematic approach tor performance measurement, analysis, and review by 2025
- Develop and implement a systematic approach for performance improvement by 2024
- Standardize city-wide (and departmentspecific) procedure manuals by 2025
- Develop and implement a systematic complaint-management system by 2024













Over the course of the past 215 years, the City of Pompano Beach has continued to evolve from a small farming settlement along Henry Flagler's Florida East Coast Railway to one of Florida's largest 25 cities – a progressive, thriving destination!

The City provides an exceptional quality of life – with amenities like 3 miles of beaches, 700 acres of parks, golf, tennis, endless watersports, gaming, dining and a plethora of options for cultural experiences, including 5 cultural venues and a 3,000 seat Amphitheater. Pompano Beach is a well-known fishing and diving destination with direct access to the Atlantic Ocean through the Hillsboro Inlet and sought-after diving sights, often called the 'Shipwreck Capital' of south Florida.
