The meeting was held to evaluate the proposals received in response to the City's Request for Proposals (RFP) E-03-22 to establish a contract for unleaded gasoline and diesel fuel on behalf of the Southeast Florida Governmental Purchasing Cooperative Group. This meeting was posted as a "Public Meeting" both at City Hall and at the Purchasing Division of the General Services Department, and on the City's website. Six (6) firms submitted responses to the City's RFP. The meeting was called to order at 9:12 a.m.

Ross Meslin, the Broward County Fleet Manager, led the technical discussion. The Purchasing Division facilitated the meeting by explaining the evaluation procedures as detailed in the RFP and collected Conflict of Interest Statements from all voting members. Each Committee member reviewed all of the responses in advance of the meeting.

The Committee discussed each of the proposals, and scored the responses using voting forms containing the evaluation criteria published in the RFP, with the following results:

2)	Palmdale Oil Co., Inc	395
3)	Pro Energy LLC	352
4)	Mansfield Oil Co. of Gainesville	274
5)	Colonial Oil Industries, Inc	236
6)	Global Montello Group Corp	192
