3. CONTRACTOR SHALL REMOVE ALL EXISTING CONFLICTING PAVEMENT MARKINGS IN THE DRIVEWAYS BY WATER-BLASTING OR SAND-BLASTING.

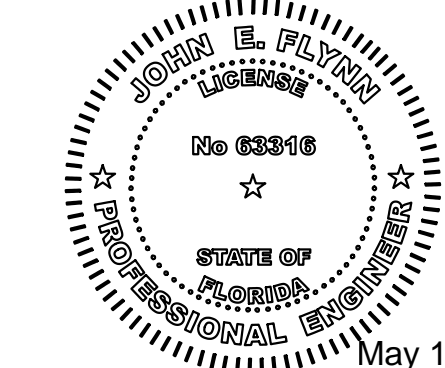
