I am very pleased to advise you that the Florida Commission on Ethics ("FCE") has determined that there is no probable cause to believe that Mayor Lamar Fisher violated Section 112.3143, F.S., pertaining to certain votes that were cast while he was a member of the City Commission as well as a member of the City's Community Redevelopment Agency ("CRA"), and that the above-referenced complaint has been dismissed. A copy of the FCE's Public Report is enclosed for your review.

Additionally, enclosed please find a copy of our invoice for legal services for representing Mayor Fisher in this matter. The allegations against Mayor Fisher arose from conduct (i.e. votes) taken in his official capacity and while serving a public purpose as mayor and as a board member of the CRA. Since the complaint has been the dismissed, Mayor Fisher is legally entitled to have his attorney's fees paid by the City. The City may have an opportunity to pursue and recover attorney's fees against the complainant pursuant to Section 112.317, F.S.
