A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, CHANGING THE DESIGNATION OF A CERTAIN RIGHT-OF-WAY WITHIN THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH CURRENTLY KNOWN AS NW 3RD STREET BOUND BY POWERLINE ROAD ON THE WEST AND NW 21ST AVENUE ON THE EAST TO A DUAL DESIGNATION OF NW 3RD STREET AND LUERENNA H. HOLLEY STREET WITH LUERENNA H. HOLLEY STREET TO BE DISPLAYED MORE PROMINENTLY ON THE UPPERMOST PORTION OF THE SIGNAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to give recognition to the contributions and public service made by LueRenna H. Holley, a longtime Pompano Beach resident by dual naming NW 3rd Street and “LueRenna H. Holley Street,” with “LueRenna H. Holley Street” to be displayed most prominently on the uppermost portion of appropriate signage; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the designation of a portion of NW 3rd Street bound by Powerline Road on the west and NW 21st Avenue on the east shall have the dual designation of NW 3rd Street and “LueRenna H. Holley,” Street with LueRenna H. Holley to be displayed most prominently on the uppermost portion of the signage.

SECTION 2. That the City Clerk is directed to forward a copy of this Resolution to Broward County so that the County may prepare and install the appropriate signage.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
