A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE PURDUE PHARMA, L.P. BANKRUPTCY PLAN; AUTHORIZING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO TAKE ALL REQUIRED ACTIONS WITH REGARD TO SUCH APPROVAL; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the State of Florida has filed an action pending in Pasco County, Florida, and a large number of Florida Cities and Counties have also filed an action *In re: National Prescription Opiate Litigation*, MDL No. 2804 (N.D. Ohio) (the "Opioid Litigation") and the City of Pompano

WHEREAS, the City of Pompano Beach has suffered harm from the opioid epidemic; and

Beach is a litigating participant in that action; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission, in Resolution No. 2021-169 did previously accept the Florida allocation of a different plan for a national distributor; and

WHEREAS, one of the Defendants, Purdue Pharma, L.P., filed for bankruptcy protection under Chapter 11, and the city has filed a Proof of Claim in said action; and

WHEREAS, Purdue Pharma, L.P. now proposes its Chapter 11 Plan of reorganization; and

WHEREAS, the Plaintiff's Executive Committee ("PEC") has proposed and recommends acceptance of the Purdue Pharma, L.P. Bankruptcy Plan; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City of Pompano Beach finds that acceptance of the Purdue Pharma Bankruptcy Plan would be in the best interest of the City of Pompano Beach and its citizens and thus accordingly approves and accepts said plan.

SECTION 2. The City Attorney is hereby authorized and directed to take all necessary actions to return all required forms acknowledging the city's acceptance of the plan to the designated recipient for the Bankruptcy Court.
