

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE REVOCATION OF A PORTION OF A DISTRICT FOUR HIGHWAY MAINTENANCE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH AND THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Pompano Beach (City) and the State of Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) entered into a Highway Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement and Certification Statement on July 26, 2013, approved by Resolution No. 2013-321; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Highway Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement, FDOT was to perform two projects within City right-of-way as part of a county-wide bicycle mobility project; and

WHEREAS, due to safety concerns of the residents from the McNab Road Community, the City wishes to approve the removal of the bicycle mobility project on East McNab Road, from South Cypress Road to North Federal Highway; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City of Pompano Beach hereby approves the removal of the portion of the project only related to East McNab Road, from South Cypress Road to North Federal Highway.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
