A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY **POMPANO** BEACH, FLORIDA, RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 2016-301, AND APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE PROPER CITY OFFICIALS TO APPLY FOR THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION REVOLVING LOAN PROGRAM FOR POINT SOURCE WATER POLLUTION **CONTROL: UPON** APPROVAL, **EXECUTE** CORRESPONDING LOAN AGREEMENT, PLEDGING OF STORMWATER UTILITY FEES AS THE REVENUES TO REPAY THE LOAN, AND PROVIDING FOR CARRYING LOAN RESPONSIBILITIES UNDER THE AGREEMENT; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes provides for loans to local government agencies to finance the construction of wastewater treatment facilities; and

WHEREAS, Florida Administrative Code rules require authorization to apply for loans, to establish pledged revenues, to designate an authorized representative; to provide assurances of compliance with loan program requirements; and to enter into a loan agreement; and

WHEREAS, the State Revolving Fund loan priority list designates Project No. SW062400 as eligible for available funding; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pompano Beach, Florida, intends to enter into a loan agreement with the Department of Environmental Protection under the State Revolving Fund for project financing; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That Resolution No. 2016-301 is hereby rescinded in its entirety.

SECTION 2. The foregoing findings are incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.

SECTION 3. The City of Pompano Beach, Florida, is authorized to apply for a loan to

finance the Project.

SECTION 4. The revenues pledged for the repayment of the loan are net stormwater

system revenues.

SECTION 5. The City's Utilities Director is hereby designated as the authorized

representative to provide the assurances and commitments required by the loan application.

SECTION 6. The Mayor is hereby designated as the authorized representative to execute

the loan agreement which will become a binding obligation in accordance with its terms when signed

by both parties. The Mayor is authorized to represent the City in carrying out the City's

responsibilities under the loan agreement. The Mayor is authorized to delegate responsibility to

appropriate City staff to carry out technical, financial, and administrative activities associated with

the loan agreement.

SECTION 7. The legal authority for borrowing moneys to construct this Project is Section

166.111, Florida Statutes.

SECTION 8. All resolutions or part of Resolutions in conflict with any of the provisions of

this Resolution are hereby repealed.

SECTION 9. If any section or portion of a section of this Resolution proves to be invalid,

unlawful, or unconstitutional, it shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force, or effect

of any other section or part of this Resolution.

SECTION 10. This Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
