KCI Notes

- KCI notes the goal is to enhance the aesthetics and operations of the Riverside Drive in a way that will transform this facility into a pedestrian friendly destination and in turn setting a new course for the development of Pompano Beach.
- KCI believes there is potential to convert the roadway into a southbound one-way corridor. The benefit of this is that the reduced pavement provides additional space for stormwater storage volume, reduced traffic noise for residents, lower traffic volumes to contend with for drivers utilizing the existing backout parking, and increased pedestrian safety.
- Interesting project: KCI was retained by FDOT District 4 to design the reconstructed portion of SR A1A from Sunrise Boulevard to NE 18th Street.
- No project schedule provided. Almost no details about their approach to public participation. This is especially important if considering drastic improvements such as converting it to a one way roadway.
- The city has recently adopted the 2070 sea level rise projections from the SE Florida Regional Climate Change Compact. If selected, the firm and project team should coordinate with the city to determine the degree to which sea level rise and king tides will be addressed by the proposed design.



- Marlin team includes three Broward County Business Enterprise (CBE) firms including Compass Point Surveyors, PL for surveying & mapping/SUE; Quest Engineering Services & Testing, Inc. for geotechnical engineering and material testing; SSN Engineering, LLC for water, sewer and reclaimed water utility improvements tasks, including drainage. Additionally, we have added Calvin, Giordano & Associates, Inc. for landscape architecture services.
- Proposal notes there are a lot of properties with front-in parking, or parking which seems to be within the City's right of way, and no sidewalks. In these areas they recommend constructing sidewalks towards the roadway and adding a drop curb to delineate the pedestrian area.
- This firm most strongly notes the sea level rise projects in the area. The application states that if sea-level rise is considered, raising the centerline of the road will be the only practical option.
- Proposed a Silva Cell system for the proposed street trees. Excellent point.
- Did not provide details on public outreach our project schedule
- The city has recently adopted the 2070 sea level rise projections from the SE Florida Regional Climate Change Compact. If selected, the firm and project team should coordinate with the city to determine the degree to which sea level rise and king tides will be addressed by the proposed design.

General Comments:

Marlin: This one stood out the most for me. Only 4 subs which makes it a bit more manageable (one of which is CGA). The 2-PM's that will be assigned previously served as FDOT managers. Numerous streetscape type projects including downtown Hollywood Blvd. Not much with City though other than RRR Dixie and Andrews Ave projects. But what impressed me the most with their submittal was their technical approach - it was very well thought out and detailed, with specifics. They recognized that corridor is functionally fractured from block to block. They conducted inspections and made several recommendations and included typical sections and some visual concepts. They also included some good suggestions for not only stormwater upgrades, but also water and sewer, and some landscape sections.

KH: They have numerous street scape projects including Hollywood A1A and PB Clematis. They have done extensive work in Pompano (including GO Bond)...they're one of our continuing contracts. I enjoy working with their staff, and they have all the qualifications and experience – they developed the Broward, Miami-Dade, and PB MPO's complete streets design guidelines. I liked their submittal overall however, although their technical approach was very detailed on process and procedure, for me it was lacking on the personal touch. I didn't see too much in there on identifying existing issues and giving it that personal touch...it was a bit generic for me.

Craven Thompson: Various similar streetscape projects in various cities, nothing significant with City though...few smaller dollar projects. They plan on using 9 subs which I though may be too much, although I did see Paola West in there which could help plans go through process. I liked their technical approach, it was detailed and specific and identified the issues, and they did perform the boundary and top survey for Riverside already. Good submittal overall.

Chen Moore: Several similar projects in Wilton Manors, LBTS and Coral Springs. Numerous projects in the City, mainly drainage and lift station but they did do Old Pomp streetscape with CRA. I also liked their technical approach and they were detailed and specific and identified the issues with varied conditions along the corridor, localized flooding, and private encroachments in R/W. Good submittal overall.

IBI: Good submittal overall. Appeared more of the streetscape projects were out of state. They have done work in Pompano (MM and Apollo Pk, and MLK FDOT LAP, as well as Briny Ave). I've worked with both their PM's Patrica and Debra and they were phenomenal to work with on Briny Ave. Although the technical approach was very detailed on process and procedure, for me it was lacking on the personal touch...a bit generic for me.

KCI: Formerly Keith and Schnars who has a long history of work in Pompano. Appeared more focused on landscape architecture but they do have streetscape experience, primarily with FDOT projects from what I saw. Their technical approach was good and they put effort into it and conducted field reviews with recommendations (one of which was converting one way southbound only from 14th to NE 2nd), but I thought overall it was a bit too streamlined for me.
