AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE PROPER CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE A FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE LABOR AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE POMPANO BEACH PROFESSIONAL FIRE FIGHTERS, LOCAL 1549 OF THE INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF FIRE FIGHTERS AND THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH FOR THE PERIOD BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2016 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2019, RELATING TO WAGES FOR FISCAL YEARS 2017-2018 AND 2018-2019; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the current Labor Agreement between the Pompano Beach Professional Fire Fighters Local 1549 of the International Association of Fire Fighters and the City of Pompano Beach provided for an agreed upon reopener in fiscal years 2017-2018 and 2018-2019 as it related to Article 15 Wages Merit/Step Increase and Longevity; and

WHEREAS, the parties have participated in good faith negotiations in accordance with the mandate of the labor agreement; and

WHEREAS, the parties have reached a mutual agreement regarding Articles 15 and 21 as each article relates to wages of the membership; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, ten (10) days' notice has been given by publication in a paper of general circulation in the City, notifying the public of this proposed ordinance and of a public hearing in the City Commission Chambers of the City of Pompano Beach; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing before the City Commission was held pursuant to the published notice described above, at which hearing the parties in interest and all other citizens so desiring had an opportunity to be and were, in fact, heard; now, therefore,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That an Amendment to the Agreement between the Pompano Beach Professional Fire Fighters, Local 1549 of the International Association of Fire Fighters and the City of Pompano Beach for the period of October 1, 2016 to September 30, 2019, a copy of which amendment is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as if set forth in full, is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. That the proper City officials are hereby authorized to execute said Agreement.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage.
