MINUTES

1. Annual Plan FY 17

Ms. Atria stated that there is not a lot of room for additional projects in the Public Art budget for the next fiscal year. The estimated quote from the contractor who created the mold for the painted pompano to do 12 future statues is \$45,000.

Ms. Aycock and Mr. Davis suggested adding the McNab Park mural to the Annual Plan under completed projects. The Public Art Committee worked with Pompano Proud in the past to approve the murals installed at McNab Park and it was a great success. Anyone who wants to donate work should be encouraged.

Ms. Atria stated that the 9/11 memorial will not likely be done before the 2016 fiscal year ends in October.

Ms. Gomez explained that since the Public Art budget is funded in part by the utilities the Utilities department asked to have some of the art relate back to the utilities. There is no set project, but the Utilities division has asked if the Public Art Committee would set aside a portion of their budget to fund a project that incorporates their facilities or equipment.

MOTION by Tobi Aycock and seconded by Linda Houston Jones to approve the Fiscal Year 2017 Annual Plan and to bring it to the City Commission for their approval. All voted in favor.
