NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rex Hardin, Mayor of the City of Pompano Beach, and on behalf of the City Commission, do hereby proclaim the month of May 2019 as:

HAITIAN HERITAGE MONTH

and encourage all citizens to join me in honoring the growing Haitian Community and also in celebrating the unique history, culture and people of the Republic of Haiti.
