SUBJECT: Interlocal Agreement with the City of Margate

This interlocal agreement with the City of Margate will formalize the existing arrangement with the City of Margate and the City of Pompano Beach to supply each other with potable water if necessary. Possible situations include contamination, natural disaster or other emergency situation. The will be valid for five years with three (five year) renewal periods.

As mentioned in the agreement, the City of Pompano Beach has had the improved connection designed and will have it constructed this summer, sharing the costs with Margate, approximately \$79,000 each. The construction contract for \$135,868.00 was approved at the March 28th commission meeting. An agreement for Construction Engineering Inspection services was entered into for \$22,180.00. Funds from the Capital Improvement Project (16288 Utility Water Interconnect) are being used. Margate will be invoiced for its portion when the project is complete. Any future repair and maintenance costs will also be split.

This agreement and design will also be used as a template when updating the four other interconnections with Fort Lauderdale and Broward County
