**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE ATLANTIC BOULEVARD COMPLETE STREETS IMPROVEMENT PROJECT TO BE ADMINISTERED IN COOPERATION WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) approved the Broward Complete Streets Master Plan on February 14, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, the Atlantic Boulevard Complete Streets Improvement Project, from NW 31<sup>st</sup> Ave. to NW 6<sup>th</sup> Ave. has been identified as a high-ranking project in the Complete Streets Master Plan's list of recommendations; and

**WHEREAS**, a resolution from the Pompano Beach City Commission stating support for the project is required to establish funding eligibility; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Pompano Beach endorses the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) delivering the Atlantic Boulevard Complete Streets Project on Pompano Beach's behalf, fully administering the design and construction phases of the project; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the responsibility of the City of Pompano Beach to maintain or coordinate the maintenance of the roadways after the project's completion; now, therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA:**

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing "Whereas" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct, and are hereby made a part of this Resolution.

**SECTION 2.** The City supports this Complete Street Project, as listed on the attached Exhibit “A,” to improve conditions for bicyclists and pedestrians.

**SECTION 3.** This Resolution shall become effective upon passage.
