Contract Need/Background

Invitation to Bid (ITB) E-09-23 was issued to obtain bids to establish a contract for a new complete stormwater collection system. This project consists of installing storm drainage water piping, signage, and reconstructing project roadways, swales, and thermoplastic pavement markings. The project area includes portions of NW 16th Lane, portions of Copan's Road, and portions of NW 17th Lane, in Pompano Beach, Florida. This work is required to improve surface water runoff collection and provide safe passage for pedestrian and vehicular traffic throughout the area. The improved surface water runoff collection will also provide additional flood protection. Bid award is recommended to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.
