Issue

Staff is seeking City Commission approval of a Resolution to execute a Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement (MMOA) with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) pertaining to Construction Agreement Number 2016-C-491-0004 and Community Aesthetic Feature Agreement Number 2016-M-491-0001 (CAFA). The agreement is necessary as the City wishes to make improvements to the bridge and FDOT requires the City to maintain said improvements on FDOT's property.

Recommendation

Staff recommends Approval of the Resolution.

Background

The City is seeking to make improvements to the Atlantic Boulevard Bridge such as installing tension sails including fabric with necessary mounting hardware and posts; bridge traffic "Wyoming" railing with required transitions; bascule pier murals including aluminum mounting channels; graze and flood lighting; tender's house standing seam metal roof, weathervane and cupola; bascule pier siding; esplanade under bridge including counterweight slab; cantilevered walkway including adjacent sea wall; decorative concrete panel wall with enclosed area; pedestrian railing; stainless steel lighting bollard; LED and flood lighting; seating/retaining wall; and, bird netting and landscaping to include plant materials and irrigation.

In order for the City to conduct said improvement, FDOT requires the City to enter into a maintenance agreement and agreeing to conduct periodic maintenance and upkeep of the improvements. In addition, FDOT requires the City to make a cash deposit in the sum of

\$41,150.00, monies that are intended to be used by FDOT in case the agency wishes to remove said improvements and the City does not comply with the terms of the agreement.
