SUBJECT: FY 2019 Rollover Requests

Every year departments usually have capital or operational items that need to be rolled over into the new fiscal year. The funds to be rolled over are associated with items that were approved in the preceding year's budget. The reason the funds need to be rolled over is that the expenditures were not fully spent or encumbered by September 30, 2018.

Attached is a spreadsheet that identifies each rollover request. The requests in nature are to purchase capital equipment or finish projects that began last fiscal year, but will not be completed until the new fiscal year. Other requests for carrying forward funds are to pay for expenses that are budgeted on a calendar year basis.

Below you will find the summary of all requested rollovers and appropriations detailed by fund and division. Please note that the funds to be rolled over will be taken to the City Commission for consideration and approval on October 23, 2018.

<u>General Fund</u> \$1,961,118

Tourism \$18,500

- a) \$13,000 To cover photoshoot and advertising campaign
- b) \$500 To purchase clothing
- c) \$5,000 To print the Watersports Brochure

City Clerk \$23,817

- a) \$2,217- To cover Tuition Reimbursement
- b) \$21,600 To Granicus Closed Captioning Services

Cultural Affairs \$17,800

a) \$17,800 - To cover the Amphitheater Enhancement (Painting of the rails)

Development Services \$100,000

a) \$100,000 – For Comprehensive Plan Amendment – This project is required by the City's Strategic Plan in order to be in compliance with any State requirements and also the County's recent BrowardNEXT comprehensive plan amendment. The City issued RLI # RLI E-46- 17 for this project and has received responses. The first selection committee meeting took place on Friday, September 29th.

Fire \$9,800

- a) Fire Operations \$7,900 To purchase computer for EOC
- b) Fire Prevention \$1,900 To purchase desktop computer

Public Works \$259,935

- a) \$51,552 Streets: To purchase F450 and related accessories
- b) \$109,929 Streets: To purchase a new dump truck
- c) \$11,020 Streets: To purchase a concrete planer, saw, trailer and curb builder that was budgeted for FY18.
- d) \$10,000 Grounds: To fund accessories needed for vehicle purchases budgeted in FY18
- e) \$77,434 Cemetery: To purchase vault and a marker budgeted for in FY 18

Parks and Recreation \$186,499

- a) \$70,645 To purchase Pool Filtration System for the Aquatics Center Pump Room
- b) \$115,854 To replace the Transit Bus

Non-Departmental \$1,344,767

- a) \$17,772 –To cover the Offerdahl's event with funds from previous fiscal year 2018.
- b) \$1,326,995 To fund cloud design and construction of a sports complex at the City's 12 Acre Park in Palm Aire. Approved by the City Commission on 3/27/2018. Reso #18-123.

Utility Fund \$688,991

- a) \$150,000 Three membrane feed pumps will be packaged along with two additional VFDs on FY 18-19. These items are included in the Transfer Station Rehabilitation project.
- b) \$60,000 To purchase a sludge return pump. Utilities Department is currently researching different pump options for the required application and will procure this item in FY 2018-2019.
- c) \$15,880 These actuators have been purchased. The remaining amount is to be allocated

for installation in a valve and actuator replacement project.

- d) \$13,564 Before purchasing this new software SCADA Software iClient, research found compatibility issues with the existing Windows program on the SCADA servers and view nodes. More research is needed to determine if a Windows upgrade on all existing SCADA computers is required.
- e) \$10,063 Staff is waiting on an additional well telemetry quote from the vendor.
- f) \$3,105 To purchase (2) SCADA Servers. Before purchasing this new SCADA servers, software compatibility issues with the existing Windows program needs to be resolved.
- g) \$34,189 To purchase of Sludge Return Pump #1.
- h) \$51,344 The request to rollover these funds will purchase the first bleach storage tank.
- i) \$52,884 The request to rollover these funds will purchase the second bleach storage tank.
- j) \$54,470 The request to rollover these funds will purchase the third bleach storage tank.
- k) \$2,952 The request to rollover these funds will purchase the second water plant bleach bulk storage tank Level Transmitter.
- 1) \$2,863 The request to rollover these funds will purchase the first water plant bleach bulk storage tank Level Transmitter.
- m) \$3,628 The request to rollover these funds will purchase the third water plant bleach bulk storage tank Level Transmitter.
- n) \$22,669 To purchase a water plant ammonia feeder.
- o) \$10,475 –The membrane flush valve actuators have been purchased. The remaining amount is to be allocated for installation costs in a valve and actuator replacement project.
- p) \$3,530 –The membrane concentrate valve actuators have been purchased in FY 2018. The remaining amount is to be allocated for installation costs in a valve and actuator replacement project.
- q) \$16,550 Additional research is needed on SCADA software compatibility and ability to transmit plant security video to Water Plant.
- r) \$13,258 The Valves and actuators have been purchased. The remaining is to be allocated for installation costs in a valve and actuator replacement project in FY 2019.
- s) \$3,000 –To purchase SCADA software related to compatibility issues mentioned above need to be resolved before moving forward with this purchase in FY 2019.
- t) \$18,431 Utilities requests these funds be rolled over and allocated towards the valve and actuator installation project in FY 2019.
- u) \$130,463 This is for Jet-vac services.
- v) \$10,974 Plumbers expense for Reuse Installations for continued funding of Oasis Reuse connection.
- w) \$4,698 The three laptops have not been purchased during FY 2018, as they will be beginning the introduction into Asset Management Software for FY 2019. Once the Asset Management Project commences an appropriate tablet or laptop will be defined.

<u>IT Fund</u> \$19,489

a) To rollover funding and purchase the last batch of radios for the Fire Department.

Central Services Fund \$78,392

- a) \$77,000 To Cover Professional Procurement Services
- b) \$1,392 Clothing

Health Insurance Fund \$184,065

a) \$184,065 - Per the requirements of the Affordable Care Act/ Medical Loss Ratio Rule, these funds will be proportionately used to provide a refund to employees, covered by the City's HMO (family coverage), based on the family deduction they paid for their coverage for plan fiscal year 2017.

Risk Management Fund \$58,122

a) \$58,122 - To rollover funding to upgrade the software claims system.

Total rollovers and additional requests for all funds amount to \$2,990,177.
