SHORT TITLE

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE PROPER CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE A QUIT CLAIM DEED FOR RIGHT-OF-WAY EXTENDING NE 47TH STREET; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

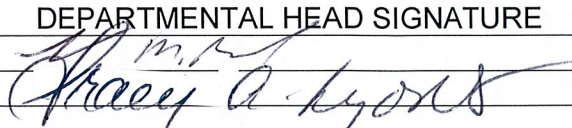
Summary of Purpose and Why:

NE 47 Street is a land-locked alley being accessed through an easement established on the commercial property located at 4699 N Federal Highway. As illustrated on copies of the legal description and legal sketch, approximately 10 feet of each City-owned property located at 4700 NE 18 Avenue (Lot 6 Block 32) and 4710 NE 18 Avenue (Lot 5 Block 32) are being dedicated in order to extend NE 47 Street westward to be connected to NE 18 Avenue. As a result, residential properties along NE 47 Street will gain access from public right-of-way, rather than an access easement. Subsequent to the dedication, a small portion of Lot 6 (50.19 sq.ft.) is being separated from the main lot. The small portion of Lot 6 must be unified with Lot 5 in order to create a continuous parcel of land. There are three companion items on the City Commission agenda associated with the NE 47 Street extension.

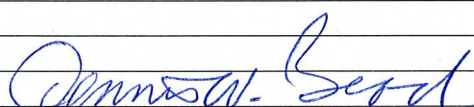
- A. Executing a Quit-Claim-Deed
