SUBJECT: Ordinance: E-01-24 Inspection and Cleaning of Stormwater/Utilities Systems

Jet Vactor Truck on Call Service Contract

## **Approval Request:**

City Commission approval to award RFP E-01-24 Inspection and Cleaning of Stormwater/Utilities Systems Jet Vactor Truck on Call Service contracts between the City of Pompano Beach, TeleVac South, Inc. (primary / Contract #12325), and Envirowaste Services Group, Inc. (secondary / contract #12336).

## **Explanation:**

Mandates governed by the EPA's Clean Water Act impose monitoring and reporting requirements for stormwater discharge through the City's NPDES (National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System) permit. Annual inspections and cleanings of the system are required provisions of the permit that ensure state and federal clean water standards are met.

The City currently has 126 miles of stormwater pipe. The as-needed contract will help the City comply with regulatory guidelines and provide on-call Jet-Vactor services for utility-related emergencies.

## **Recommendation:**

The Utilities Department recommends that RFP E-01-24 for Inspection and Cleaning of Stormwater Systems and Jet-Vac On-Call Services be awarded to the highest-ranked firms, TeleVac South, Inc. (primary) and Envirowaste Services Group, Inc. (secondary).
