I wanted to provide a brief overview regarding municipalities that have city-owned and operated cemeteries within Broward, Miami-Dade, and Palm Beach Counties.

Miami-Dade County

Miami-Dade County has only one confirmed municipality that owns and operates a cemetery: the City of Miami (Miami City Cemetery).

Broward County

Cities such as Hallandale Beach, Pompano Beach, Fort Lauderdale, Dania Beach, Boca Raton, and Deerfield Beach have city-owned cemeteries.

The majority of Broward municipalities, however, do not operate cemeteries and instead rely on private providers.

Palm Beach County

Palm Beach County has the highest number of municipalities with city-owned cemeteries in the tri-county area.

Cities including West Palm Beach, Lake Worth Beach, Delray Beach, Boynton Beach, Jupiter, and Lantana operate municipal cemeteries.

Summary

Approximately 15 to 19 municipalities operate city-owned cemeteries

Approximately 85 to 90 municipalities do not operate municipal cemeteries
