

WHEREAS: safe, clean, and sustainable water resources are vital to Florida's environment, public health, economy, and overall quality of life for both residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS: with Florida's finite water supplies and a growing population, the demand for sustainable water solutions continues to rise; and

WHEREAS: water reuse provides a means for conserving and augmenting Florida's precious water resources and is key to the state's sustainable water future; and

WHEREAS: Florida has risen to be the national leader in water reuse—reusing 900 million gallons of reclaimed water per day to conserve freshwater, support healthy ecosystems, and supplement our potable water; and

WHEREAS: Florida has established the encouragement and promotion of water reuse as state objectives in Chapters 373 and 403, Florida Statutes, and

WHEREAS: WateReuse Florida, the state section of the WateReuse Association, has proclaimed the third week of May to be Florida Water Reuse Week; and

WHEREAS: the City of Pompano Beach has joined with WateReuse Florida, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection, and the South Florida Water Management District in encouraging and promoting water reuse and conservation; and

WHEREAS: the City of Pompano Beach has been a longstanding champion of water reuse, conserving nearly 25 billion gallons of freshwater over the past 35 years to protect our water supply and natural resources for future generations; and

NOW, THEREORE, I, Rex Hardin, Mayor, on behalf of the City Commission of Pompano Beach, Florida, do hereby proclaim the week of May 18th through May 24th, 2025, as:

WATER REUSE WEEK

in the City of Pompano Beach and encourage all residents, businesses, and institutions to help protect our shared water future by using reclaimed water wisely and conserving water every day.
