Subject: Approval to Piggyback City of Margate Florida Contract #2014-006 for Asphalt Surface Preservation with Rejuvenation Agent

Contract Need/Background

The Public Works Department's Streets Division requests approval to piggyback the City of Margate Florida Contract #2014-006 for the furnishing and installation of "Asphalt Surface Preservation with Rejuvenation Agent" as needed, from Pavement Technology, Inc. As the lead agency for a joint bid with the City of Miami, the City of Margate issued bid 2014-006, and awarded a contract to the vendor listed above. The current contract is valid through May 7, 2019.

Attached you will find copies of a memorandum from the Streets Division, a quote from Pavement Technology, Inc., the executed contract, the Pavement Technology, Inc. response to the City of Margate bid, and the contract renewal document.

Funding

As needed purchases for asphalt rejuvenation will be funded from account 302-7303-541.65-12 / 07925: Capital Projects / Road Resurface Program. The estimated expense for the City's completion of the road resurfacing program will be \$142,947.48.

Award Recommendation

After review of the City of Margate bid, it is recommended that as needed purchase orders be issued to Pavement Technology, Inc., the awarded vendor, for Asphalt Surface Preservation with Rejuvenation Agent, at the prices specified in the City of Margate Florida Contract #2014-006.
