Re: Hurricane Nicole – Federally Funded Sub-award Grant Agreement

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I would like to request your approval to prepare an agenda item on Consent for the Commission meeting of April 25, 2023. This agenda item will involve a Resolution recommending approval and authorizing the Commission to enter into a subaward grant agreement with the State of Florida Division of Emergency Management.

The subaward grant agreement between the City of Pompano Beach and the State of Florida Division of Emergency Management is a federally funded public assistance agreement based on the Presidential disaster declaration (FEMA-DR-4680) in response to Hurricane Nicole.

The federal cost share of the eligible costs under this agreement is equal to seventy-five (75) percent with a state cost share of twelve and one-half (12.5) percent for emergency protective measures taken by the City when the City's Emergency Operations Center (EOC) was activated under the City's Local State of Emergency. This reimbursable award includes direct costs incurred from Hurricane Nicole as well as reasonable administrative costs required by the City in order to administer the public assistance process. The estimated amount eligible for reimbursement is \$56,000 (\$64,000 less 12.5% City's cost share). Therefore, this is a positive fiscal impact to the City.
